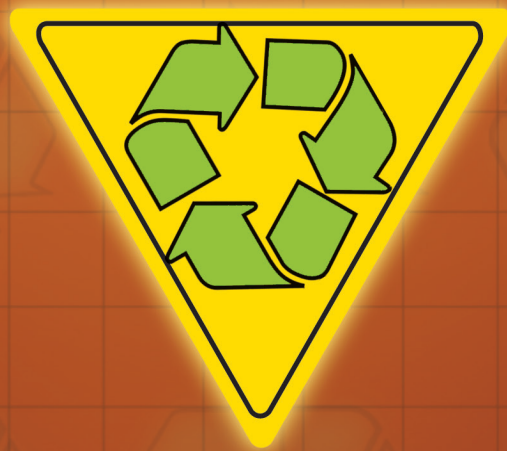

UNACCEPTABLE AND CONDITIONALLY ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

This document outlines materials that are not accepted at Alter facilities and materials that may be accepted if certain conditions are met. This list is not intended to be comprehensive. Common sense and best judgment will be used to determine which materials can be managed in a safe and responsible manner. Special situations or requests for deviations are to be discussed and cleared with your account executive prior to delivery. Alter's account executives and facility managers are available to answer questions or to discuss concerns you may have.

INBOUND SHIPMENTS MAY BE SUBJECT TO CERTIFICATION AND/OR INSPECTION.

MATERIAL	CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE
ACETYLENE TANKS	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT.</u>
AMMONIA (GAS ABSORPTION) REFRIGERANT UNITS	Ammonia and sodium chromate removed in accordance with applicable regulations.
AEROSOL CANS	Empty and punctured or crushed.
AIRCRAFT MATERIAL	Verified free of radioactive sources and no aluminum/lithium alloys or chemical residues.
APPLIANCES (Household/Commercial) (refrigerators, dryers, microwaves, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, commercial coolers, dishwashers, furnaces, freezers, clothes washers, hot water heaters, kitchen ranges/ovens, thermostats, drinking fountains, fluorescent lights, trash compactors, vending machines, whole or parts, etc.)	No PCB-containing small capacitors and ballasts, mercury-containing components (bulbs, switches, thermocouples) and refrigerants (CFCs, HFCs, ammonia, etc.). <u>Refrigerant/CFC Recovery Certification Required.</u> Select facilities equipped to demanufacture may accept (may be subject to fee). <u>INQUIRE AT SCALE.</u> No ammonia or asbestos containing appliances. IOWA: Accept from IDNR-certified demanufacturers only. Must bear unique mark.
ASBESTOS-CONTAINING SCRAP (furnaces, pipes, building materials, etc.)	Asbestos removed in accordance with applicable regulations.
BALLASTS	Labeled "No PCBs" or manufactured in USA after 1998; accepted at Nonferrous Receiving only
BARRELS, DRUMS, AND OTHER CONTAINERS (pails, buckets, etc.)	Empty with no residual content; entire top removed or cut in half to allow for inspection. <u>Containers formerly containing "acute" hazardous waste (as defined in 40 CFR 261) only accepted if certified triple rinsed. Provide MSDSs for any drums bearing hazard or warning labels.</u>
BATTERIES, LEAD-ACID ONLY	Select facilities may accept lead-acid batteries (car, industrial) if segregated; no "universal waste" batteries (e.g. NIMH, NiCd, lithium or Absolyte).
BERYLLIUM OR MATERIALS CONTAINING BERYLLIUM	Select facilities may accept w/pre-approval from Safety Director
CAPACITORS	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT</u>
COMPRESSORS/"SEALED UNITS"	Drained of oil with drill hole visible, <u>Refrigerant/CFC recovery certification required.</u>
COMPRESSED/LIQUEFIED GAS CYLINDERS (oxygen, propane, chlorine, argon, refrigerants, ammonia, etc.)	<u>MUST INFORM SCALE AT TIME OF DELIVERY. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN REJECTION OR DEDUCTION.</u> Segregated, valves removed, <u>empty and depressurized and either a fist-sized opening on side or cut in half; Acetylene tanks are NOT accepted.</u> Single use non-refillable cylinders if pressure-release valve punched, painted with a high visibility "X"

MATERIAL	CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE
DROSS, METALLIC	Certification and documentation that the dross is not hazardous and has been managed in compliance with applicable legal requirements.
ELECTRONIC SCRAP (VCRs, radios, office equipment, copy machines, computers, keyboards, CPUs, printers, circuit boards, other peripherals, etc.)	Electronic parts without circuit boards, PCB capacitors, leaded glass, toner or cathode ray tubes are acceptable. If segregated from other scrap, select facilities may accept whole (may be subject to fee). <u>INQUIRE AT SCALE.</u>
FLUIDS (oil, fuel, coolant, antifreeze, cutting oil, hydraulic oil, solvents, etc.)	All fluids to be drained prior to delivery. See also AEROSOL CANS, BARRELS/DRUMS, HEATERS, HYDRAULIC EQUIPMENT, OIL FILTERS, PAINT CANS, PUMPS, TANKS, and VEHICLES.
GAUGES AND MEASURING DEVICES	Verified free of radioactive sources.
HEATERS, OIL-FILLED SPACE/ PORTABLE, PRE-1980	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT</u>
HEAVY EQUIPMENT	See VEHICLES
HYDRAULIC EQUIPMENT, PRE-1980 OR INDETERMINABLE	May contain PCB oil; requires PRE-APPROVAL FROM ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGER
LEAD-PAINTED SCRAP	Select facilities may accept if identified and segregated during unloading.
LIGHTING FIXTURES, OUTDOOR AND INDUSTRIAL/COMMERCIAL (sodium/mercury vapor, metal halide, fluorescent, neon)	No PCB capacitors and ballasts and free of bulbs. Select facilities may accept as appliance. See APPLIANCES
MAGNESIUM TURNINGS	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT.</u>
MERCURY (thermometer, thermostats, switches, relays, elemental, gas regulators, flame sensors, etc.)	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT.</u> Mercury components must be removed from scrap metal.
MILITARY AND GOVERNMENT SCRAP	Certification statement stating free of explosive, radioactive, and hazardous materials.
NATURAL GAS PIPELINE SYSTEM COMPONENTS	May contain PCBs, asbestos, and mercury components; requires PRE-APPROVAL FROM ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGER
OIL FILTERS	Select facilities may accept if hot-drained of free-flowing oil for a minimum of 24 hours, punctured and containerized when delivered.
PAINT CANS	Open, empty and dry.
PERFORATING GUNS (Frac Pipe)	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT.</u>
PUMPS, PRE-1980 OR INDETERMINABLE (sump, well, etc.)	May contain PCB oil and mercury switches; requires PRE-APPROVAL FROM ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGER
RADIOACTIVE SOURCES (gauges, measuring devices, medical equipment, cameras, underground pipe, etc.)	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT.</u>
REFRIGERANT-CONTAINING SCRAP (refrigerators, heat pumps, motor vehicle air conditioners, window and terminal air conditioners, water coolers, dehumidifiers, etc.)	Refrigerant to be properly recovered in accordance with federal or state regulations using EPA-certified recovery equipment. Refrigerant/CFC recovery certification required. Select facilities that recover refrigerants may accept (may be subject to fee). <u>INQUIRE AT SCALE.</u>

MATERIAL	CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE
SHELLS, MUNITIONS (brass shells, munitions casings, etc.)	Segregated from other commodities and discharged or otherwise spent.
TANKS, ABOVEGROUND AND UNDERGROUND STORAGE (mobile, portable, fixed)	A minimum 2-foot hole at both ends or cut in half; no residues and odors.
TIRES	Select facilities may accept if attached to an auto body (may be subject to fee or deduction). INQUIRE AT SCALE.
TRANSFORMERS; OIL-FILLED CIRCUIT BREAKERS	New production or dry transformers or drained with <1 PPM PCB with laboratory test results; All others require PRE-APPROVAL FROM ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGER.
TRASH OR NON-METALLIC RECYCLABLES	Unless incidental in volume to scrap, DO NOT ACCEPT or load deduction taken.
TVs, MONITORS, SCREENS (CRTs, LEDS, flat, etc)	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT.</u>
VEHICLES (crushed, whole or parts including motors, transmissions, and fuel tanks)	No mercury switches, batteries, lead parts, refrigerants, antifreeze, fuel, and oils. Refrigerant CFC Recovery Certification Required. Select facilities may accept "as is" if uncrushed and facility is equipped to demanufacture. INQUIRE AT SCALE.
WASTE, HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC (as defined by Federal, State, or Local regulations)	<u>DO NOT ACCEPT.</u>
WHITE GOODS	See APPLIANCES.
WIRE/CABLE	Free of asbestos and/or PCBs.

REFRIGERANT RECOVERY NOTICE

IT IS AGAINST THE LAW TO KNOWINGLY VENT OR RELEASE INTO THE ENVIRONMENT ANY REFRIGERANT OR SUBSTITUTE FROM APPLIANCES AND MOTOR VEHICLES.

PERSONS WHO KNOWINGLY PROVIDE FALSE STATEMENTS OR RELEASE REFRIGERANTS INTO THE ENVIRONMENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO EPA CRIMINAL PENALTIES UP TO \$37500 PER DAY FOR EACH VIOLATION.



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
